Funding will cover salaries, costumes, set design, construction, marketing, touring, and free admission for low-income students.

Box 332 Waldorf, MD 20604	\$25,000	June	To support their ballet training program for children, teens and adults by providing scholarships for six of their classical ballet students, training in the Vaganova method of ballet and for the cost of studio equipment.
